

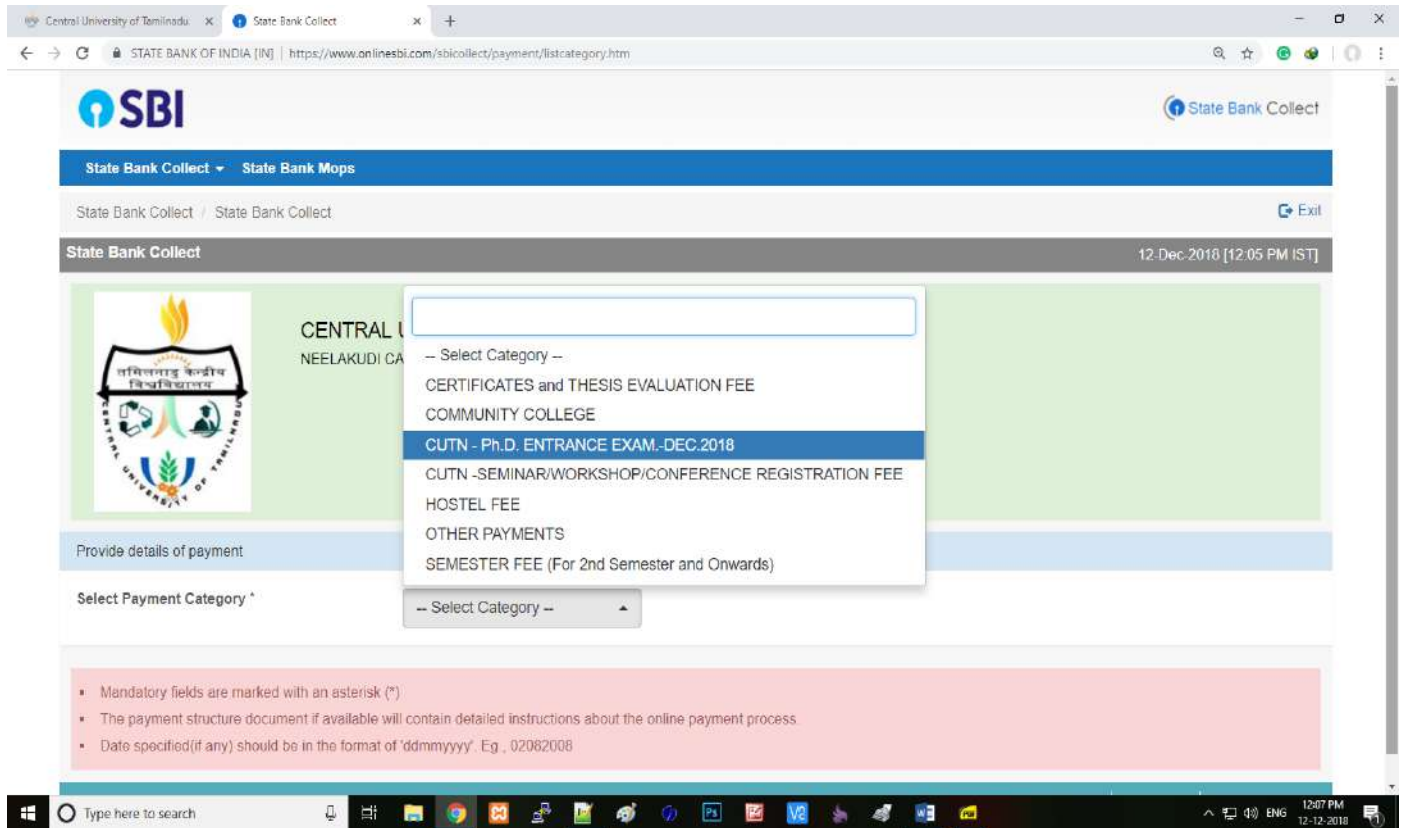
INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES

 - c. Details of application fee payment

7. The applicant will not be able to modify the existing data after the Final Submission.
8. After confirmation of fee payment, applicants will be able to download their **Admit Card** for appearing Entrance Test.
