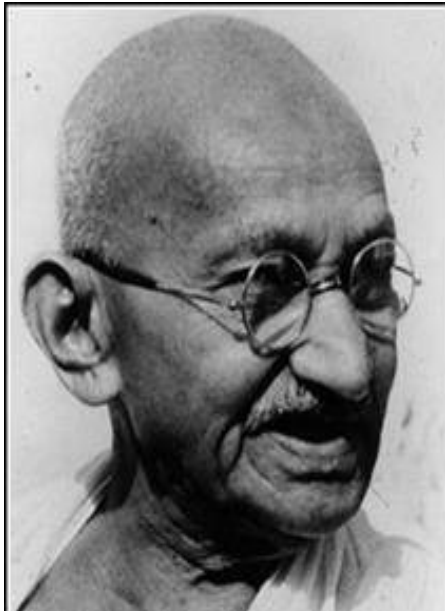

# ADMISSION GUIDELINES FOR NRI/FOREIGN NATIONALS

Application of Foreign Nationals nominated by the Govt. of India under scholarship scheme and direct admission through self-financing scheme shall be entertained for different Courses at Central University of Tamil Nadu. The Foreign nationals need NOT appear in the Central Universities Common Entrance Tests (CUCET) for admission; however, they should have passed the equivalent Qualifying Examination from an Indian or Foreign University/ Institution. Provision to the extent of 10% of the total seats in each course on supernumerary basis for Foreign Nationals is available. For more details related to program of study and eligibility criteria, please visit [www.cutn.ac.in](http://www.cutn.ac.in)

## Admissions Procedure:

Every year foreign nationals are admitted to various programmes of study under the following categories:

- (I) Direct admission for Self-financing Students:- The Foreign Student, who wish to join under Self-financed category are required to submit their application along with bio-data and academic qualification on the prescribed format to International students division, Central University of Tamil Nadu, Thiruvavur 610 005 India (email: [admissions@cutn.ac.in](mailto:admissions@cutn.ac.in)). The respective Student (and copy to concerned Embassy) will be informed about the university decision.

Note: The admissions to M.Tech and MBA programmes under the DASA (Direct Admissions of Students Abroad scheme of MHRD. The detailed information and admission procedure for this year is available on the website ([www.dasanit.org](http://www.dasanit.org)).

- (II) Under the Cultural Exchange Fellowship Programme of Govt. of India:- Candidates desirous of admission under this Fellowship Programme are required to apply through the Indian High Commission/ Embassy / Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) as the case may be for consideration. In case the applicant is found suitable, confirmation of their admission will be sent directly to the concerned agency sponsoring their admission.

### Eligibility conditions:

1. Minimum eligibility qualifications for international students will be the same as for Indian students for each program mentioned in the University Prospectus. For more details, please visit University website <http://www.cutn.ac.in>
2. The program on which eligibility is to be relied upon must be from an Institute included in the list of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). New Delhi- 110002 (<http://www.aiuweb.org>)
3. In case the University/Board is not included in the said list, the candidate has to obtain and submit an Equivalence Certificate to this effect from the Association of Indian Universities.
4. English translations of all transcripts, duly attested, are to be submitted.
5. Candidates applying from their own country should get their transcripts attested by the concerned accredited authorized government agency and also duly certified by the Indian Embassy or Consulate.
6. On being granted admission, all applicants should produce their Students Visa within one month of completion of admission formalities. In case of failure to obtain a visa within the stipulated period, the admission shall stand cancelled. A copy of this visa is to be submitted in the Office of the International Students Division, CUTN
7. Upon arrival in India every foreign student must register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO).

### (I) At the time of submitting the application

(a) All the Foreign nationals under self-finance category should submit their application on prescribed format along with all relevant documents, which can be downloaded from the website, [www.cutn.ac.in](http://www.cutn.ac.in).

(b) The applications of scholarship - holding Foreign Nationals (under various schemes) are routed through the Indian Council for Cultural Relations/ Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Educations), Govt. of India, New Delhi. The antecedents of the candidate have been verified by the forwarding Agencies/ Ministry and found in order.

(c) Copy of the grade transcripts with the explanation of the assigned grades including certificate of secondary school, Diplomas and Degrees of examination passed. Original Certificates should not be sent.

(d) Attested copies of the syllabi and curricula of the qualifying degree adopted in the Colleges/ Universities attended with full details.

(e) Copy of the passport indicating your nationality and personal details.

(f) Financial undertaking either a letter of recommendation from the Govt. certifying that the fees will be paid by the Govt. or a copy of the student's bank statement showing a balance of US \$1000 ( in case of the 2-yr post graduate program) or US \$ 2000 ( in case of a Ph.D. and integrated program).

(g) That they have adequate knowledge of English as per requirements of the Course.

(h) If English is not the first language or language of medium of instruction (during secondary & tertiary education), a pass in any of the following two tests will be required:-

- (i) The test of English as a foreign language (TOEFL), administered by the Educational Testing Service in the US, in which scores of at least 580 overall and 4.0 in the test of written English are required. The computer based test requires scores of at least 240 overall and 4.0 in essay writing. The internet based test requires scores of at least 95 overall with a minimum score of 20 in writing.
- (ii) The International English Language Testing Service (IELTS) test, administered by the British Council, in which scores of 6 in each section and an overall score of 6.5 are required.
- (iii) Test scores more than two years old will not be accepted for consideration.

## **(II) At the time of admission**

(a) They have valid Residential permit in India granted for studies /Student Visa/Research Visa for the prescribed duration of the concerned Course.

- (b) They fulfil the minimum eligibility requirements.
- (c) Candidates must submit medical fitness certificate duly verified by the Ministry/Agencies.
- (d) The Degrees / Certificates of the candidates must be recognized and approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU) / Commonwealth Universities/ International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees / Certificates.
- (e) The inter-se merit among the applicants of various foreign nationals will be decided by the university, which shall be deemed as final
- (f) All the eligible foreign nationals are required to fill up the Registration Form prescribed by the University at the time of admission

Presently, over 28,500 books, 114 CDs/DVDs and 200 printed journals are possessed by the library. It boasts the access to more than 6000 online electronic journals through UGC-INFONET, e-Shodh Sindhu, J-Gate, SCIFINDER to name a few. The IndiaStat.com database also subscribed towards the benefits of researchers and students for social science discipline. The library is completely automated having an online portal that can be easily accessed by the users. The library implemented KOHA - an open source software package which is an integrated library management system that supports all housekeeping operations of the library. KOHA consists of modules on acquisition, cataloguing, circulation serials control and OPAC. Anyone can access these services within the campus only. Recently the RFID technology is being used for security purposes. There is a separate digital library centre having 30 computers running on high speed internet. Overall, it offers seating capacity to over 100 users. The library is open from Monday to Friday (8am - 8pm) and on Saturday (10am - 6pm). For convenience of the users, the reprographic facility is also available inside the library. Other salient features include air conditioners, availability of portable water and property counter. Recently the MoU signed with INFLIBNET for Shodhganga project towards the sharing accessing of the Electronic Theses and Dissertations. And also the Urkund & iThenticate Anti-Plagiarism Software access are enabled by Central Library to check the theses and other publications for the benefits of users community. The library system and staff is meticulously focused for providing comfortable, user friendly environment so as to enables learning and knowledge creation.

## Campus Wi-Fi network: Campus Connect

Recently, the administration of the Central University of Tamil Nadu added a feather in its cap by the introduction of well-connected high speed efficient internet facility. This can be accessed by all students, research scholars and faculty members from any corner of the campus premises.

## **Health care**

The University health centre has both male and female doctors and a nurse. The health centre is well-equipped with up to date stock of medicines and other facilities. The University administration is constantly updating the medical technologies for comfort and convenience during emergency situations. The health centre is open 24 x 7 all through the year with efficient ambulance service.

## **Sports facilities**

Apart from education and research, the University also aims to promote a healthy culture of sports. There is three day sports meet that is held annually in the university. Students engage themselves in variety of sports including basketball, badminton, football, cricket and volleyball. Indoor sports facilities include with respect to table tennis, carom, chess and yoga. There are separate indoor gyms in both girls and boys hostel.

## **Cafeteria and related facilities**

Fresh and healthy food and snacks are available at the cafeteria by Vasan Restaurant. It is accompanied with a juice corner, sweet centre and a bakery also. North and south Indian and Chinese cuisines are efficiently and neatly served by the cafeteria.

## **Transport**

Three buses are provided by the University that runs within the campus and to Kanglangerri, the nearest market place. These buses run in morning, during lunch time and in the evening to facilitate easy and comfortable movement.

### **Bank, ATM and Post office**

The University has a branch of State Bank of India open from 10 am to 4 pm on all working days. There are two ATMs, one in the main campus and another outside the residential campus. There is a post office in the main campus having all the basic facilities.

### **Hostels**

Since most of the students are from outside Thiruvavur, hostel facilities are of critical importance. The hostel is the second home for all students and scholars. Homely environment and safety is encouraged in the hostels. There are six hostels, of which, four are for students and two for research scholars. There are 2 boys hostel, 2 girls hostel which can house 500 students each. The rooms are allotted on sharing basis.
