- The candidates are required to bring their own research proposal and prepare themselves well for presenting their plan of proposed work during the interview. However, the finalization of research area/ topics of the candidates will be made after admissions in consultation with the supervisor.
- Please bring the copy or re-prints of each paper you have published in referred national / International Journals, if any.
- Those candidates who are not attending the interview on the date specified, their application will summarily be rejected and their names will not be considered for preparation of rank list.
- No TA/DA would be payable for attending the interview.
- Please note that this call is merely a call for interview and not gives a guarantee for admission.
- After the preparation of rank list, admission letter to the selected candidates will be sent by email only. The said list will be displayed in the university website. No hard copy of letter will be despatched.
- The University reserves the right to fill up or not to fill up the intake, cancel or modify the dates of interview and modalities of admission pertaining to PhD.

- **Students are required to confirm their participation in the interview by giving a reply mail latest by 10th July 2016.**
- The university reserves the right to withdraw the admission AT ANY TIME. Further, in case the candidate does not fulfil the minimum qualification/ required percentage of marks in qualifying examination or supplies any false information, his candidature/admission would be cancelled.

FAQs

May I know about the department?

The Department of Economics has risen to prominence in recent years by attracting renowned scholars to its faculty and by carefully selecting its student body. Six members of our department are one Professor, two Associate Professors and three Assistant Professors. The priority areas for PhD research at CUTN, based on current faculty research interests, are: Financial Economics, Macro Economic Policy, Education and Development, Public Economics, Economics of Education, Health Economics, Development Economics and Agriculture Economics. We offer an environment with a good research infrastructure and ample opportunities for informal interaction. Courses and seminars offered by the department foster an intellectually active and stimulating environment. Apart from regular UGC JRF/SRF/RGNF etc, Students can avail University UGC Non-Net fellowship as monthly Rs 8000/- rupees. The Department hosts lecture and seminar series of renowned faculty both nationally and internationally.

How do I reach CUTN Thiruvarur?

A: Thiruvarur can be easily accessed by bus from nearby towns like Thanjavur (62 kms), Trichy/Tiruchchirappally (120 kms), Karaikkal (41 kms), Mayiladuthurai (41 kms) and Pondicherry (145 kms). There are also direct trains to Thiruvarur Junction from Chennai, Coimbatore and Ernakulam. As Thiruvarur is located en route Velankanni, long distance bus services to Velankanni pass via Thiruvarur town. The closest airport is located in Tiruchchirappally.

Q: Is Central University of Tamil Nadu situated in Thiruvarur town?

A: The 516-acres campus of Central University of Tamil Nadu, Thiruvarur, is located at Kangalanchery which is 10 kms on the way from Thiruvarur town to Mayiladuthurai. There are frequent buses from Thiruvarur town bus stand (a 3-minute walk away from the Thiruvarur Junction railway station) towards Mayiladuthurai. Take a bus towards Mailaduthurai/Mayavaram, elite at Kangalancherry. From Kangalancherry, it's about 2.5 KM.
