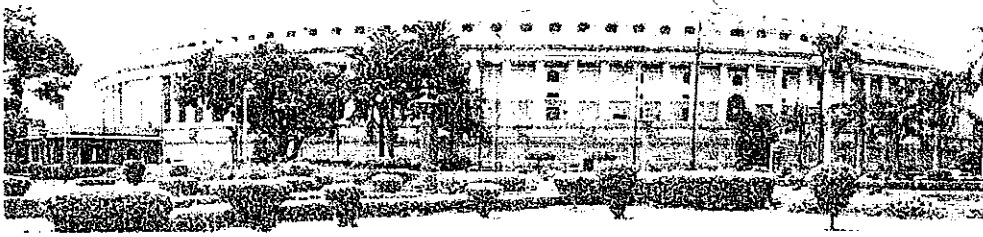

**Fellowships for Writing Books**

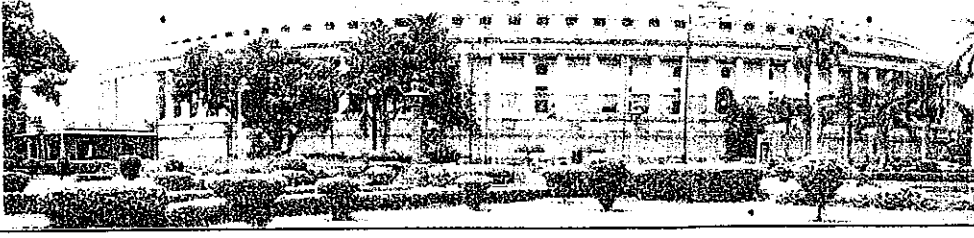
The Lok Sabha Secretariat proposes to grant twenty-five Fellowships for writing books every year on subjects of parliamentary interest.
