For admission to the PhD programme in Physics, candidates are instructed to appear for a possible scrutinizing examination followed by personal interview on 24th July 2017. The scrutinizing exam will be a multiple choice based examination and will be conducted only in case the number of candidates appearing for the interview is more than 30.

Instruction to the candidates:

1. Report 30 min. before the entrance exam/interview commences.
2. The following certificates/documents in original have to be produced at the time of interview:
 - a) Attested copies of ALL academic records starting from 10th Std and attested copy of Caste Certificate (if applicable)
 - b) All original mark sheets for verification and the master degree in Physics.
 - c) Community Certificate in original (if applicable)
 - d) CUCET 2017 admit card for verification
 - e) Photo identity for verification and one recent passport size photograph
 - f) CSIR-UGC/NET/GATE/SET qualified certificate (if any)
 - g) M. Phil/M. Sc. project reports/theses (if applicable)
 - h) A short write-up on your area of interest/ statement of purpose.
3. To know details of research carried out in CUTN, the candidates are advised to see the individual faculty profile in the department of physics website.

4. No TA/DA will be provided for attending the interview.
5. This is your call letter for interview. No call letter for interview will be sent to candidates by post
6. Candidates are requested to come prepared to stay at-most one more day, if needed.
