

Report on National Digital Payments Mission (NDPM)

As per UGC's D.O. No. F. 1 -11201 7(Secy), dated 6th June.2017 with reference the Ministry of Human Resource Development's letter No. C.3001810112017-CDN dated 31st May, 2017, the Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN) has communicated to all the stakeholders and employees on 18-07-2017 regarding the need of implementation of digital payments using Online IMPS / BHIM App/ Debit Cards / AEPS under the National Digital Payments Mission (NDPM) of MHRD and has initiated/encouraged for digital transactions for all the activities such as **(a)** all receipts and payments related to the functioning of CUTN vis. Student fees, exam fees, vendor payments, salary/wage payments etc.; **(b)** all students' service in the hostel; and **(c)** all canteens and business establishments on the campus. In view of this initiative the CUTN has enabled the online fee payment for the students from the Academic Year 2017-18. Salary payments for the employees has already been done through RTGS since 2015-16. From June, 2017 to September, 2017, the University had done 593 digital transactions with multiple individual payments through RTGS. Further CUTN is planning to sensitize/train all the stakeholders to adopt digital transactions using the BHIM App by linking their bank accounts with the mobile number/Aadhaar number. CUTN is committed to the objectives of NDPM and moving towards cashless transactions.
