The Guidelines for each competition are given below.

- **SKIT COMPETITION**

Number of participants: 6-10

Time limit - 15 minutes

Guidelines

- The maximum time limit is 15 minutes. There will be a warning bell on 12 minutes and second on 15 minutes.
- The judgement will be based on the performance in accordance with the theme.
- Interested candidates should register on or before 7th September 2018.
- The medium of language should be English.
- There will be a registration fee of Rs.30/- (the whole group).

- **SLOGAN WRITING COMPETITION**

Theme: Working Together to Prevent Suicide.

Guidelines

- Interested candidates should register on or before 7th September,2018 and submit slogans on 9th September ,2018 to below mentioned email ID
