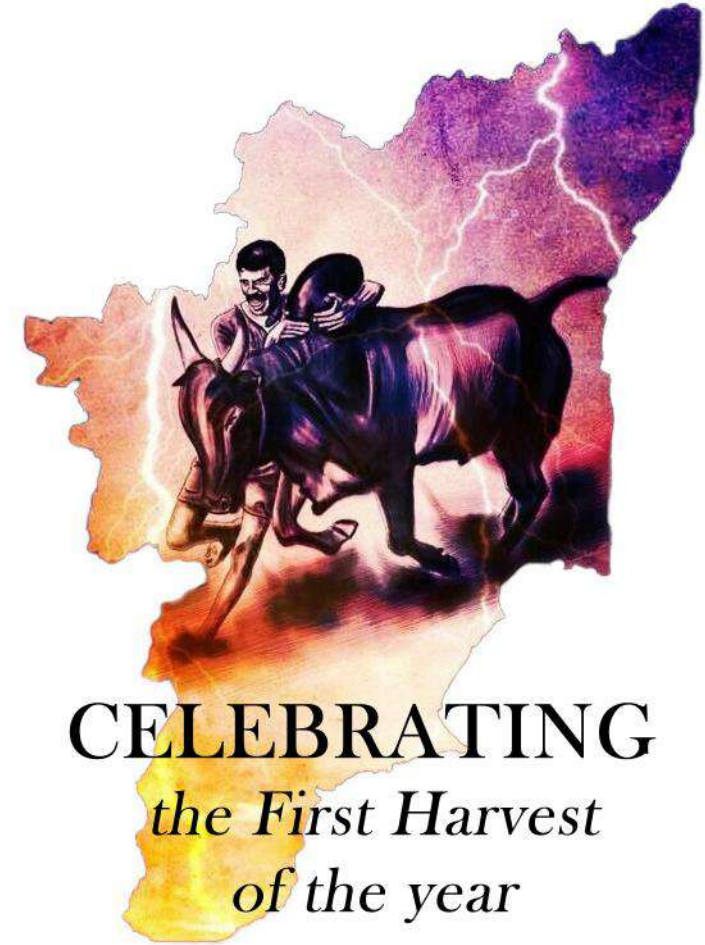

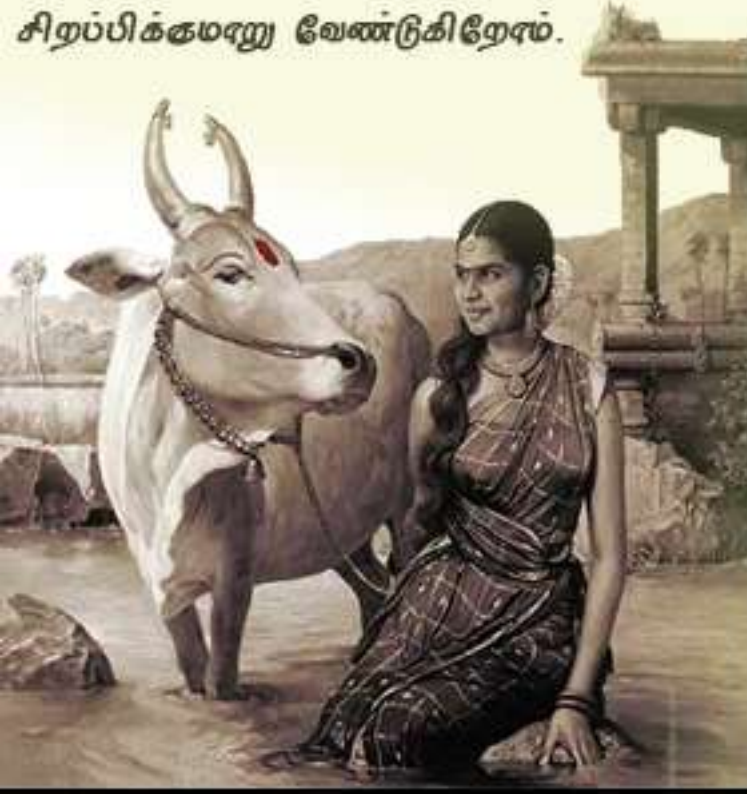

Pongal is one the most popular harvest festivals of south India Mainly of Tamil Nadu. Pongal falls in the Mid-January every year and marks the auspicious begining of Uttaraayanam - Sun's journey northwards. Pongal festival lasts for four days. This four day long festival of Tamil nadu is celebrated for showing gratitude to the nature.

Day 1 Kappu Kattu

This day falls on the last days of the month Margazhi. On this day houses are cleaned and old thing are burnt. Three medicinal plant leave are taken like , Neem, Popala, Avaram senna are kept in the corners of the houses and fields as these plants have high medicinal valuses.

Day 2 Suriya Pongal

This day is mainly celebrated to convey appreciation to the sun god for a successful harvest. Part of the celebration is the boiling of the first rice of the season consecrated to the sun surya mangalyam.



Day 3 Maatu Pongal

This day is celebrated to glorify cattle that help farmer in a myraidways. On this day, the cows are bathed and decorated with garlands and fed. Jallikattu is also being conducted on this day.



Day 4 Kaanum Pongal

On the Last day where families used to gather on the river banks and have a sumptuous meal. It is also time for some traditional dances such as kumi and kolattam.
