As a profession, social work officially originated in the 19th century as a movement primarily experienced within the United States and United Kingdom. After the demise of feudalism, those in poverty were seen as a direct threat to the social order, so the government formed the Poor Law and created an organized system to provide care to them. While the Industrial Revolution sparked great leaps in technological and scientific advancements, the great migrations to urban areas throughout the Western world led to increased social problems and in turn social activism. During this time, rescue societies were initiated to provide support to resolve the problems of poverty, disease, prostitution, mental illness, and other afflictions

Central Library

The centralized library for the extensive use functions 12 hours per day help the student to enrich with knowledge and to be intellectually sound. The library has a collection of about 19,000 books. Of these, more than 2000 books are cataloged as reference books (Handbooks, Dictionaries, Encyclopedias, etc.,) and the rest are Text books and general books. Besides the printed books, the library also has 104 CD's/DVDs and subscribes to 20 print journals.

Mess & Canteen

The mess is available for the student, Staff, researcher and faculties and provides Nutritional food for all in the campus with hygiene. College canteen provides variety of snacks and foods in an affordable price.

Computer Centre

Computer centre/ Free wifi there is a full fledged computer center which enables the students and faculties to enrich and update their knowledge from the online resources. The whole campus provides 24 hours free wifi facility

Multi Purpose Hall

A well-furnished Multipurpose Auditorium with a seating capacity of 700. The auditorium can be used as indoor stadium and also for large gatherings.

Hostel Facilities

Hostel facilities are available for 1500 students and residence for research scholars (including both married and unmarried) in the University. The design and infrastructure are on par with western standards.

Health Centre

The health center is amidst students hostel / staff residential area and academic zones. It provides primary health care and emergency services to the University community. The health care has four beds of IP care and fully equipped ambulance and 24 hours pharmacy services.

- The Department of Social Work provides rigorous field work practice and helps the students to being confident and take up any activities.

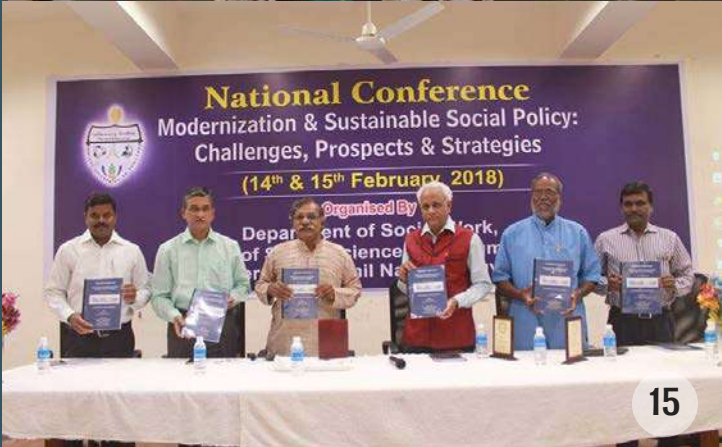
