## (1) ADDENDUM

3.1.3 (Essential qualification of the post of Assistant Professor)

VII) For Tourism and Hospitality Management:

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in Tourism / Travel / Hospitality Management from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university and two years of professional experience after acquiring Master's degree. Preference will be given for candidates with Ph.D. in relevant discipline.
- ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) in the relevant discipline conducted by the UGC or a similar test accredited by the UGC or who are or have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET. The conditions mentioned above (3.1.3 (I)) for candidates registered for Ph.D. prior to July 11, 2009 will be applicable.

2.1. (16) Subject & Area of Specialization for Commerce "Organizational Behaviour / Human Resources / Information Systems / Banking & Finance / Taxation"

Subject & Area of Specialization under 2.1. includes "**Open**" in addition to the mentioned areas of specialization for the posts of **Professors**.

(2) A relaxation of 5 % may be provided in marks from 55% to 50% to the Ph.D. degree holders at the Graduate and Master's level for the SC/ST/OBC / PWD categories for the purpose of eligibility and for assessing good academic record during direct recruitment to teaching positions, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.
