- ❖ Abstracts will be selected through a Select Committee. The Criteria for selection will be based on originality, method and relevance to the conference theme.
- ❖ Selected Abstracts will be notified by 05-MARCH, 2021 **MANUSCRIPT OR FULL PAPER SUBMISSION**
- ❖ Word limit: 3500 to 5000 words including foot notes, reference, tables and figures.
- ❖ Font style: Times New Roman.
- ❖ Font size: 12 fonts for content and 10 for footnotes.
- ❖ Line spacing: 1.5 for content and 1 for footnotes.
- ❖ Alignment: Justified Justify.
- ❖ Page margin: 2.5 on all sides.
