Agenda Item 32/1: Introductory remarks of the Chairman:-

The Chairman welcomed the members of the Executive Council and said that the last EC was held on 29.04.2020 and the resolutions are implemented. Due to the COVID 19 situation, on line classes were going on. Results of final semester examinations of six departments have been declared in July 2020. Steps are being taken to declare the results of final semester examinations of other Departments before end of August following UGC norms. He further informed that the hostels of the University has been taken over by the State Govt. Administration for COVID Quarantine centre. He emphasized that all precautionary measure are being taken by the University against COVID 19. CUTN has started online classes for remaining semesters from 16.07.2020. Then, Honourable Chairman requested the Member Secretary to go ahead with the agenda items. Before moving with agenda items, the Member Secretary proposed a Complimentary Motion by Prof. Karpaga Kumaravel as follows:

"I would like a move a Complimentary Motion in appreciation of the Vice-Chancellor, Prof.A.P.Dash for the efforts taken by him, during his tenure as Vice-Chancellor from 06.08.2015 to 05.08.2020 for the overall development of the Central University of Tamil Nadu.

When we reflect on these five years of his tenure as Vice-Chancellor, CUTN has remarkable improvement and significant performance in all the parameters.

I would like to record some of his main contributions in this Executive Council:

- 1) From 9 Departments with 27 Regular Faculty Members in August 2015, the CUTN has now grown into 28 Departments with 162 Regular Faculty Members as on July 2020. (7 Faculty Members are to join soon).
- 2) Among the new Central Universities established after 2009, CUTN has fared very well and has been ranked at 101 150 in the NIRF 2020 overall ranking.
- 3) Under his Academic Leadership and Motivation, the Research Publications of CUTN have achieved the H-index of 33 and i-10 index of 925 with a total impact

factor-of 596.

<u>Agenda Item 32/5:</u> Approval to draw the loan of Rs.95.20 Crores from HEFA regulated through MHRD: -

As per MHRD's approval for construction of One Girls Hostel, One Boys Hostel and One Academic Block through HEFA under Window-3 vide Lr. No. F.47-4/2018-CU-V, dated 20-09-2019, the Loan application has been submitted to HEFA for Rs.95.20 crores and HEFA has agreed to provide the Loan and conveyed vide Lr. No.SAN/CUTN/506/2019-20, dated 04-02-2020. Copies of the same are placed at **Annexure - III** for kind reference.

As per guidelines, the repayment will be as follows:

- Principal Repayment: 20 half-yearly instalments of Rs.4.76 Cr. each. Repayment to commence at 6 months from the date of first disbursement. First instalment of principal portion shall be debited automatically on signing of agreement.
- University Share of Principal portion under Window-3: 10% of Rs.4.76 Cr. =
 Rs.47.60 lacs each instalment and Rs.95.20 lacs p.a. Balance Principal portion of Rs.428.40 Lakhs each (Annual Payment- Rs.856.80 Lakhs) to be sanctioned by UGC/MHRD as Capital Grant.
- Rate of Interest = 8.50% p.a. and Interest Payment frequency: Quarterly (March, June, Sept., Dec.). Penal Interest: 2% after one month of due date. Interest shall also be paid from Capital Grant and to receive Grants from UGC/MHRD;

Based on requirements of MHRD and HEFA, the following are placed before the Finance Committee for consideration and recommendation to Executive Council:

- a) Approval for "Construction of One Academic Building-IV, One Girls Hostel and One Boys Hostel" through CPWD on Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) mode;

Agenda Item 32/6: Revision/Fixation of various fee structure: -

The following proposal recommended by the Academic Council in its meeting held on 19th February 2020 and being placed in the ensuing Finance Committee meeting scheduled to be held on 20th July 2020:

(i) Fee hike for rechecking of semester examination answer scripts.

Fee for re-checking of answer scripts was fixed almost seven years back and proposed to revise to Rs.200/- per paper from existing fee of Rs.100/- per paper. Further it is proposed the maximum limit of 3 (three) papers per semester, for which students can apply for rechecking.

(ii) Fee for attestation of certificates.

Many students request their certificates to be attested by Registrar or Controller of Examinations for applying for higher studies abroad. As such there is no fee collected for attestation and proposed to collect a nominal fee of Rs. 50/- per attestation.

(iii) Semester Fee structure for All Courses for Admissions 2020-21 including International / NRI Students.

The Finance Committee in its 16th meeting held on 29-03-2017 has given the direction to revise the Tuition Fee and all other Components fee/charges with 10% increase every year. Accordingly a Fee Revision Committee has been constituted for revision of fees for the Academic Year 2020-21.

Prem Davis has submitted an application that he has cleared the NEET PG 2020 Examination which was conducted by the National Board Examination for admission to Postgraduate courses in Medicine all over India with 36210th rank and is awaiting counselling at All India level and in Puducherry [domicile state] for admission. He has requested to grant Extraordinary Leave for 3 years to pursue higher studies.

As per CCS Leave rule 32[1] Extraordinary leave is granted to a Government servant-[a] when no other leave is admissible (As the M.O is eligible for grant of study leave)

[b] When other leave is admissible, but the Govt. servant applies in writing for Extraordinary leave.

As per CCS Leave Rule 12, no leave of any kind can be granted to a Govt. servant for a continuous period exceeding five years.

Presently there are two regular and two contract Medical officers in the Health centre.

Based on the above, Dr. S.Prem Davis may be granted Extra-Ordinary Leave without pay for 3 years.

Thus there can be difficulty on the part of University in following the UGC guidelines on Pen and Paper examination, Admission of students and Commencement of Regular Classes.
