The National Scholarship Portal (NSP) was opened on 18.08.2021 for receiving applications under the following UGC schemes from regular and full time students under the following four schemes for the Academic Year 2021-2022:

1.	Indira Gandhi PG Scholarship for Single Girl Child (SGC)
2.	PG Scholarship for University Rank Holder candidate (URH)
3.	Ishan Uday Special scheme for North Eastern Region (NER)
4.	PG Scholarship for Professional Courses for SC/ST candidates (PGSPROF)


The guidelines of each scheme may be accessed at 'National Scholarship Portal'. The students who are eligible and are admitted in the recognised institutions, as per the guidelines, may submit their applications through National Scholarship Portal on its website - <https://scholarships.gov.in/>

The Portal is open for receiving applications for 'Fresh' as well as 'Renewals' as per the following timelines:

Closing date for filing online applications by students	30th November, 2021
Closing date for Verification of applications by Institutions of students including re-submission of defective applications	15th December, 2021

The students are advised to submit their online applications well in time so that their institutions are able to verify applications within the prescribed timelines.

The eligible Institutions are also advised to verify applications of their students immediately after receiving the applications on Portal. It would be in the interest of students, if all the applications are verified by Institutions by **10th December, 2021**, so that they are able to correct/rectify the defected applications.
