- 1. Basic Needs – Estate Section represented by Mr. Balamurugan, Joint Registrar**  
RO water is available 24x7 in every department, hostel, and commonplace in the university. RO system is under repair in CLC-I, Physics, and old girls hostel. This will be set right soon. Meanwhile, Temporary arrangements for drinking water have been arranged. Students' Amenity Centre is not yet handed over to CUTN from CPWD. Once it is handed over, the RO water facility will be made available. Continuous water supply will be ensured in the washrooms of the departments. One napkin vending machine and incinerator are already placed at the girl's hostel.

**The committee recommends that a parking area be built for students, scholars, staff, and faculties.**

**The committee requests the authority to provide napkins in the upcoming stationery shop at Student Amenity Centre.**

**The committee requests the authority to lay Tar Road adjacent to NLBS II to Mess through the Department of Chemistry. This would be greatly helpful for the students who are on the walk to the hostel and the departments.**
