The Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN) is one of the twelve Central Universities established in India by an Act of Parliament in the year 2009. It is located at Thiruvavur, 290 kilometers away of Chennai, positioned between Thanjavur and Nagapattinam. It is located at Thiruvavur spreading over a sprawling campus of 516 acres with an excellent atmosphere for academic pursuit. The university aims at the fashioning of an enlightened society founded on a relentless pursuit of excellence through innovations in teaching-learning process, interdisciplinary studies and research. The University currently has 27 Departments under the 12 different Schools.

About Department of History:
