The 5th and 6th platoon of NCC, CUTN, 2 (P) INDEP COY, Karaikal is having a strength of 100 cadets where 50 are of Senior Division (SD), 50 are of Senior Wing (SW) cadets. Thirty-four cadets enrolled in 2018-2019, 40 cadets in 2019-20, 24 cadets in 2020-21. Now the total strength is 84. The cadets of the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year have attended CATC camp. It is a mandatory camp to attempt B and C certificate Examinations. The cadets performed well despite the constraints placed by the pandemic. Currently, the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> year cadets are awaiting their B and C certificate exam results.

On Jul 26th, 2020, a Government college ran an online quiz to remember the warriors who sacrificed their lives away gallantly in the Kargil war.

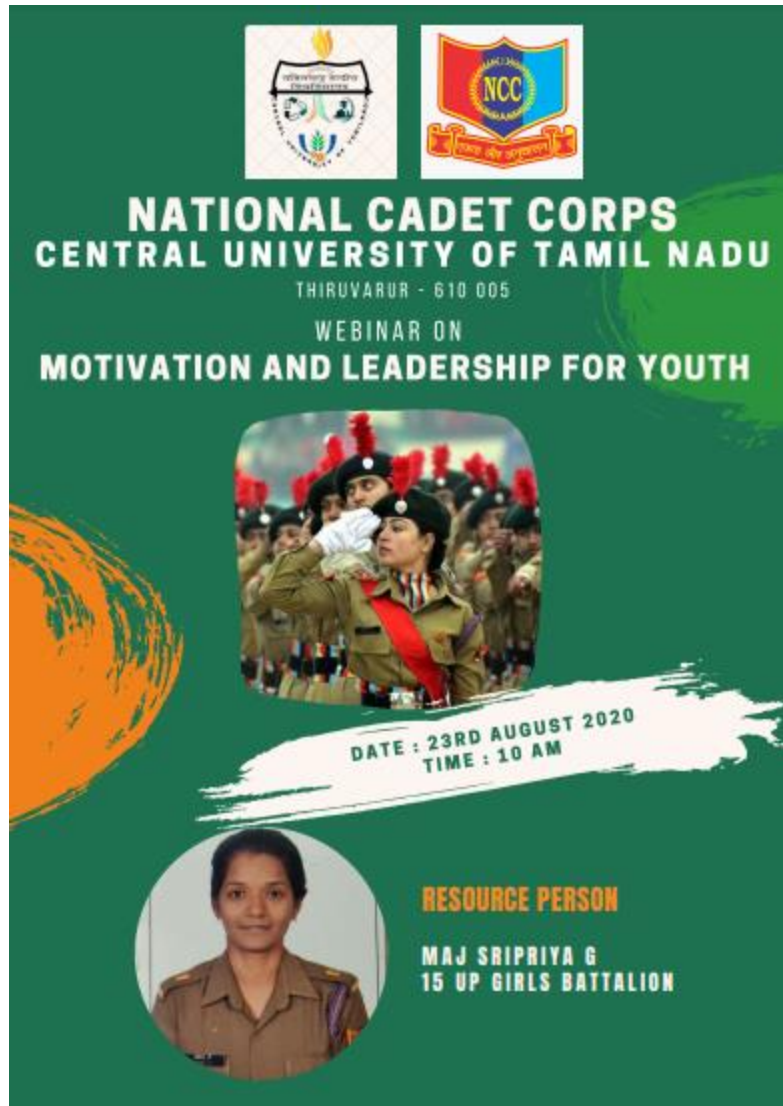
- Independence day programme:

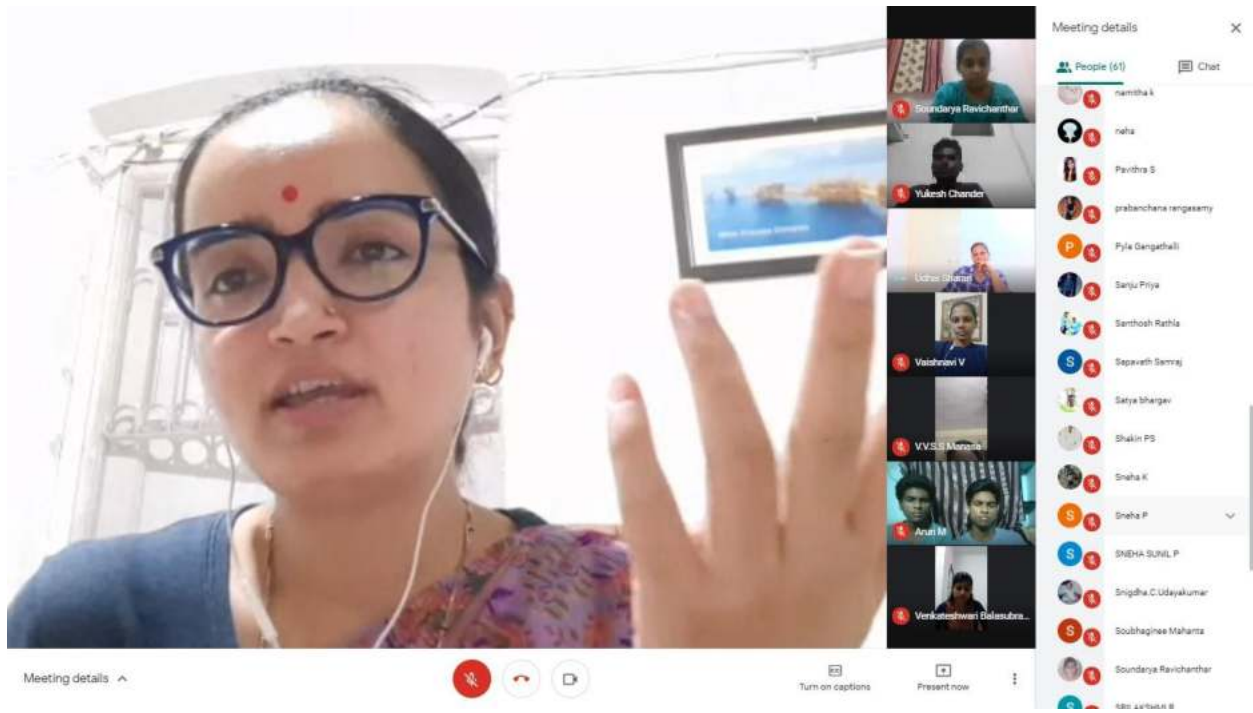


- Webinar: Motivation And Leadership For Youth:
