Dr. Boopathi P is an Assistant Professor in the Department of English Studies, School of Social Sciences and Humanities, Central University of Tamil Nadu. His research interests include Literary and Cultural Disability Studies, Refugee Literature and Life Writing Studies. For his Doctoral Research completed at EFL University, Hyderabad, he studied the identity construction of Palestinians in the life narratives written by Palestinian refugees. Prior to his appointment at CUTN, he taught at Aligarh Muslim University for three years.
