Introduction

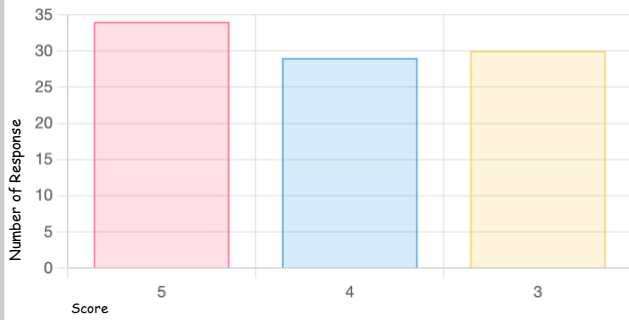

The data so collected by using an online software is also analyzed by the software and the result is reviewed by the IQAC team. Recommendations are prepared and forwarded to the management.

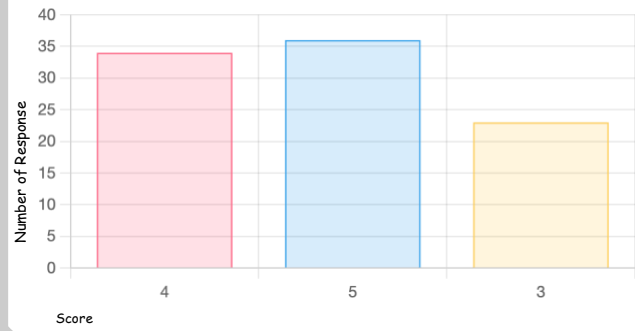
The following is the analysis of number of responses per question.



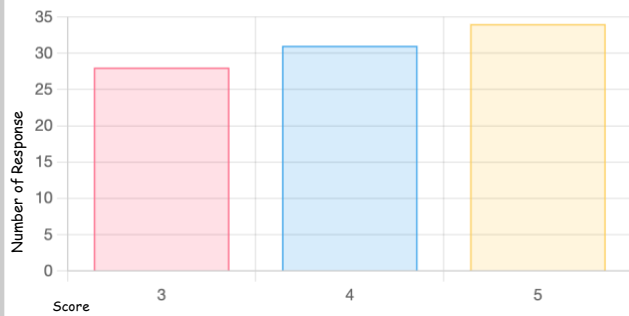

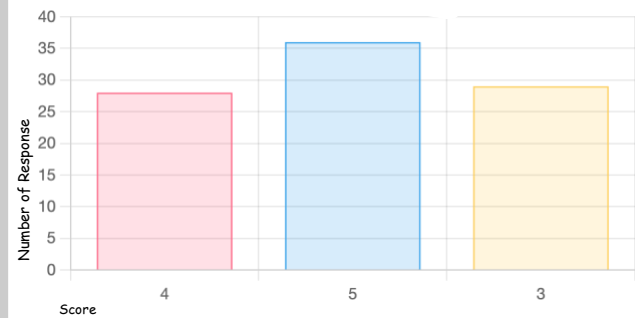

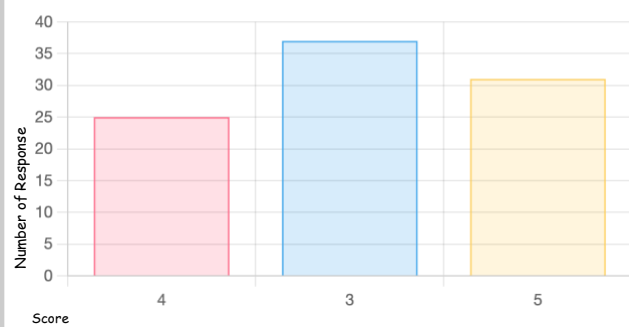
The time provided to complete the curriculum is adequate



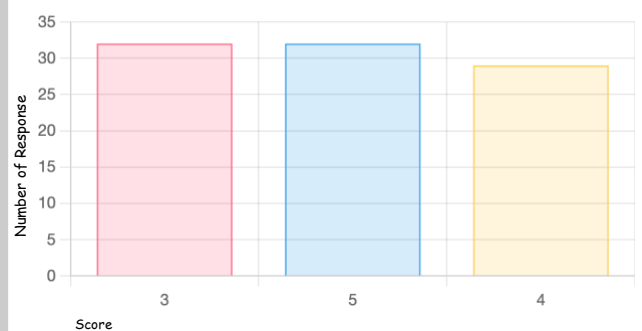

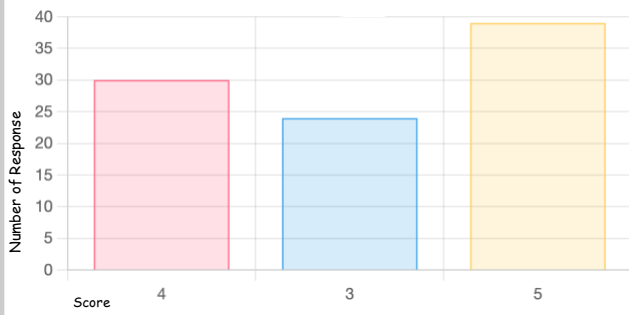

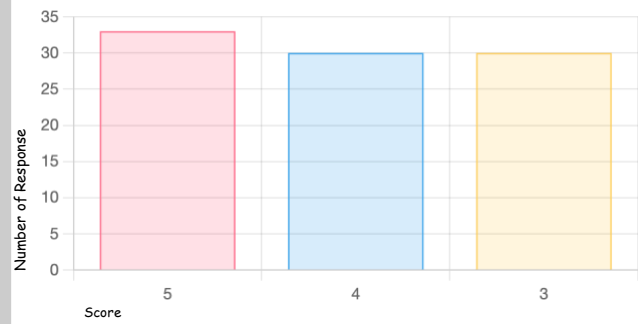

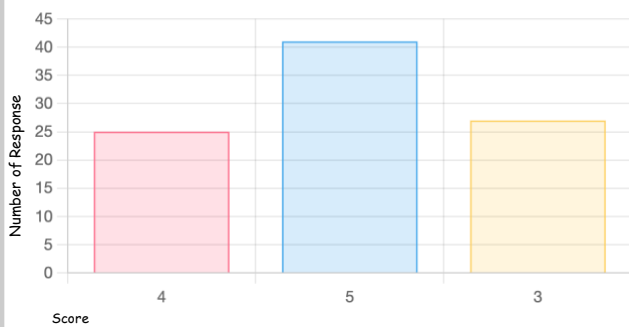

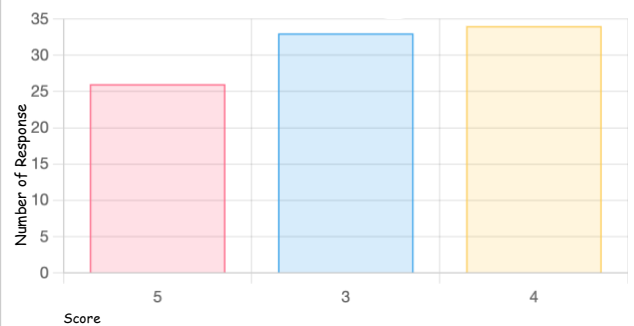

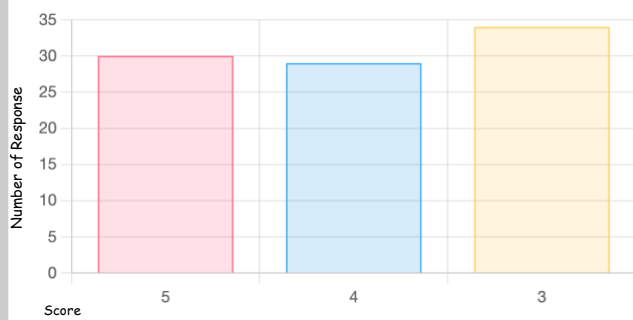

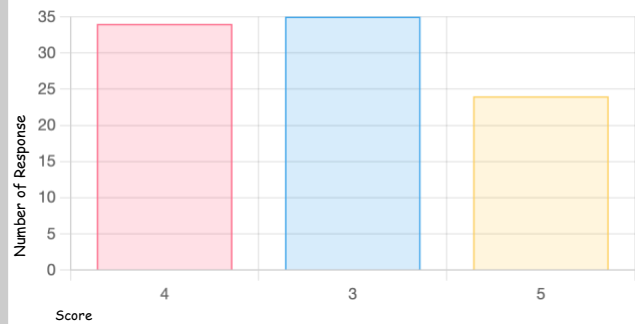

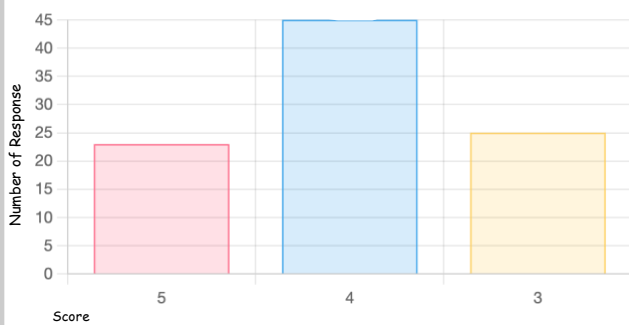

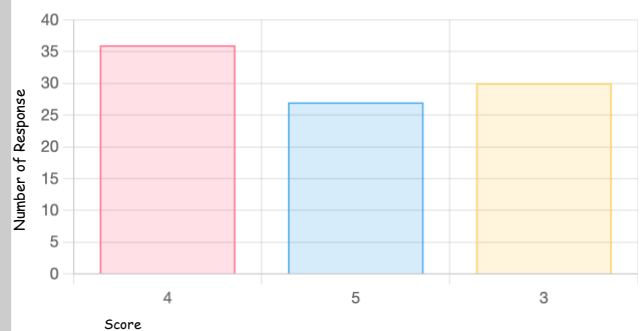
