# **ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY**

The Central University of Tamil Nadu was established in 2009, alongside eight other Central Universities, as mandated by an Act of Parliament. This initiative was a significant step by the Central Government to broaden access to higher education, particularly for individuals from disadvantaged backgrounds.

The university commenced its operations in November 2009 with an initial enrollment of just eight students in the M.A. English Studies program. Initially, it was located at the Collectorate Annexe in Thiruvarur, situated 60 kilometers east of Thanjavur. However, today, the university is situated in a prominent location, nestled along a major tributary of the renowned Cauvery river, approximately seven kilometers northwest of Thiruvarur.

The university's campuses are divided by the River Vettaaru. The Nagakudi campus accommodates faculty and staff quarters, a guest house, and Kendra Vidyalaya on the north bank, while the Neelakudi campus, located on the south bank, houses lecture halls, a library, laboratories, administrative facilities, an auditorium, and student hostels. Both campuses are enveloped by extensive, lush paddy fields, providing a serene and secluded environment, far removed from the hustle and bustle of urban life.

### **COURSES OFFERED**

The University has established 12 Schools under which 27 Departments function. The University allows adaptable teaching-learning methodology to ensure the comprehensive development of the students. The presence of diverse schools allows for an inter-disciplinary approach to higher education. The University also lays a lot of importance to community engagement. The University offers 62 academic programmes including 27 research programmes, 25 programmes, 6 integrated programmes, 3 undergraduate programmes, apart from one PG diploma course. In addition, undergraduate program and postgraduate programs are offered in collaboration Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel International School of Textiles & Management, Coimbatore, through an MoU with CUTN. Further, the University also offers nearly 20 courses through the Community College.

### **ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT**

The Department of Tourism & Hospitality Management has swiftly garnered a strong reputation as a hub for cultivating proficient and dynamic professionals in the travel and hospitality sector, all within a brief three-year span. Currently, we offer a two-year MBA program in Tourism & Hospitality Management, as well as a PhD program.

We have successfully organized two national-level conferences and our faculty members have actively participated in numerous national and international conferences and seminars.
