

Empowering Cashew Farmers: CUTN Organizes Training Program in Collaboration with Directorate of Cocoa and Cashew Development

The Department of Horticulture at the Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN), Thiruvarur, took a significant step towards the upliftment of cashew farmers in Thiruvarankulam block, Pudukottai district in Tamil Nadu. Practical application of grafting cashew seedlings was demonstrated by both speakers, ensuring a hands-on learning experience for the participating farmers.

The scientific team, comprising Drs. S. Kathiresan, V. Thondaimaan, Kaushik Rajaram, and I. Arumuka Pravin, addressed the farmers on diverse topics, including enhanced methods for utilizing biofertilizers, integrated pest and disease control, and value addition in cashew apples.

The training program concluded with the distribution of a meticulously crafted manual titled "Improved Integrated Technologies for Cashew Cultivation," written in Tamil for the ease of comprehension by local farmers. More than hundred farmers actively participated in the workshop.
