- Minimum qualifying marks to be secured in Paper II shall be 50%
- Answer scripts of the candidates for Paper-II shall be evaluated only in respect of those candidates who secure the minimum qualifying marks in Paper-I.
- Candidates who secure 50% marks in Paper II shall be called for the skill test.
