Ramesh Kumar, Assistant Professor, Department of Tamil. They have come forward with a request in their complaints to refer their answer scripts in which they failed the first-semester examination for revaluation. Dr. V. Ramesh Kumar reported no change in marks when the answer scripts were referred for rechecking.

The students and the concerned course instructor were examined before this Committee, during which there were mutual allegations by either side. The students, as well as the course instructor, maintained their earlier stands. Since there is an allegation of partiality against the Course Instructor, the Committee opines that referring the concerned answer scripts to any other University for re-evaluation by two examiners will be the best option to resolve the issue.

Therefore, the Committee recommends that the competent authority nominate two external examiners from any university other than CUTN to reevaluate the answer scripts. The Committee is not giving any findings regarding the allegations made by either party against the other. Even such a finding does not appear essential for the above decision.

This Committee also requests the students and faculties to maintain cordial relationships to avoid the recurrence of any such complaints in the future.
