
This Committee also requests the students and faculties to maintain cordial relationships to avoid the recurrence of any such complaints in the future.






Ms. Uthara, a Ph.D. research scholar in the Department of History under the supervision of Dr. Pranjal Karg, has filed a grievance against her termination.


The committee postponed the matter to the next sitting for perusing the parties' records.






