ADMISSION GUIDELINES FOR NRI/FOREIGN NATIONALS

Application of Foreign Nationals nominated by the Govt. of India under scholarship scheme and direct admission through self-financing scheme shall be entertained for different Courses at Central University of Tamil Nadu. The foreign nationals need NOT appear in the Central Universities Common Entrance Tests (CUCET) for admission; however, they should have passed the equivalent Qualifying Examination from an Indian or Foreign University/ Institution. Provision to the extent of 10% of the total seats in each course on a supernumerary basis for Foreign Nationals is available. Admission Procedure

Every year foreign nationals are admitted to various programs of study under the following categories:

a. Direct admission for Self-financing Students: The Foreign Student, who wish to join under Self-financed category are required to submit their application along with bio-data and academic qualification on the prescribed format to International students division, Central University of Tamil Nadu, Thiruvavur 610 005 India (email: admissions@cutn.ac.in). The respective Student (and copy to concerned Embassy) will be informed about the university decision. *Note: The admissions to M.Tech and MBA programmes under the DASA (Direct Admissions of Students Abroad scheme of MHRD). The detailed information and admission procedure for this year is available on the website (www.dasanit.org).*

b. Under the Cultural Exchange Fellowship Program of Govt. of India: Candidates desirous of admission under this Fellowship Programme are required to apply through the Indian High Commission/ Embassy / Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) as the case may be for consideration. In case the applicant is found suitable, confirmation of their admission will be sent directly to the concerned agency sponsoring their admission.

Eligibility Conditions

- Minimum eligibility qualifications for international students will be the same as for Indian students for each program mentioned in the University Prospectus. For more details, please visit University website www.cutn.ac.in
- The program on which eligibility is to be relied upon must be from an Institute included in the list of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU). New Delhi- 110002 (<http://www.aiuweb.org>)
- In case the University/Board is not included in the said list, the candidate has to obtain and submit an Equivalence Certificate to this effect from the Association of Indian Universities.
- English translations of all transcripts, duly attested, are to be submitted.
- Candidates applying from their own country should get their transcripts attested by the concerned accredited authorized government agency and also duly certified by the Indian Embassy or Consulate.
- On being granted admission, all applicants should produce their Students Visa within one month of completion of admission formalities. In case of failure to obtain a visa within the stipulated period, the admission shall stand cancelled. A copy of this visa is to be submitted in the Office of the International Students Division, CUTN.
- Upon arrival in India every foreign student must register with the Foreigners Regional Registration Officer (FRRO).

At the time of submitting the application

- (a) All the Foreign nationals under the self-finance category should submit their application in the prescribed format along with all relevant documents, which can be downloaded from the university's official website, www.cutn.ac.in.
- (b) The applications of scholarship-holding Foreign Nationals (under various schemes) are routed through the Indian Council for Cultural Relations/Ministry of Human Resource Development (Department of Educations), Govt. of India, New Delhi. The antecedents of the candidate must be verified by the forwarding Agencies/ Ministry and found in order.
- (c) Copy of the grade transcripts with the explanation of the assigned grades including Certificate of Secondary School, Diplomas, and Degrees of examination(s) passed. Original certificates should NOT be sent.
- (d) Attested copies of the syllabi and curricula of the qualifying degree adopted in the Colleges/ Universities attended with full details.
- (e) Copy of the passport indicating candidate nationality and personal details.
- (f) Financial undertaking either a letter of recommendation from the Govt. certifying that the fees will be paid by the Govt. or **a copy of the student's bank statement showing a balance of US \$1000 (in case of the 2-yr post-graduate program) or US\$ 2000 (in case of a PhD, and integrated programs)**.
- (g) That they have adequate knowledge of English as per requirements of the course. **If English is not the first language or language of the medium of instruction** (during secondary & tertiary education), a pass in any of the following two tests will be required:
- (i) The Test of English as a foreign language (TOEFL), administered by the Educational Testing Service in the US, in which scores of at least 580 overall and 4.0 in the test of written English are required. The computer-based test requires scores of at least 240 overall and 4.0 in essay writing. The internet-based test requires scores of at least 95 overall with a minimum score of 20 in writing.
 - (ii) The International English Language Testing Service (IELTS) test, administered by the British Council, in which scores of 6 in each section and an overall score of 6.5 are required.

Note: Test scores more than two years old will not be accepted for consideration.

At the time of admission

- (a) They have a valid residential permit in India granted for studies/Student Visa/Research Visa for the prescribed duration of the concerned course.
- (b) They fulfill the minimum eligibility requirements.
- (c) Candidates must submit a medical fitness certificate duly verified by the Ministry/Agencies.
- (d) The Degrees/Certificates of the candidates must be recognized and approved by the Association of Indian Universities (AIU)/Commonwealth Universities/ International Association of Universities (IAU) as equivalent to the corresponding Indian Degrees/Certificates.
- (e) The inter-se merit among the applicants of various foreign nationals will be decided by the university, which shall be deemed as final.
- (f) All the eligible foreign nationals are required to fill up the Registration Form as prescribed by the University at the time of admission.
- (g) Further details regarding admission of foreign nationals are available on the website <https://cutn.ac.in/iadmission-2024/>.



ADMISSION PROCESS (ICCR SCHOLARSHIP)

- Foreign students will apply for admission in CUTN with the award of ICCR Scholarship through A2A Portal (<http://a2ascholarship.iccr.gov.in>)
- No physical application of foreign students will be considered.
- No applications for a causal doctorate will be accepted.
- CUTN will scrutinize the eligibility of foreign applicants for admission and if found eligible, will upload the admission acceptance letter. The university will also issue a rejection letter for applicant (s) not found eligible for admission and waitlisted in case there is a chance of admission in the future. The decision will be uploaded and communicated on the A2A Portal (<http://a2ascholarship.iccr.gov.in>) only.

Physical Reporting of a Foreign Student at CUTN

- Student will report her/his arrival plans to the International Student Advisors (ISA) Office at international@cutn.ac.in
- Temporary transit accommodation to each foreign student will be ensured at the university campus so that on the arrival of a foreign student she/he is aware of the place of transit accommodation and will have a complete address with telephone number before landing in India.
- Receiving of students on arrival in India will be ensured by the concerned department of the University where the student has enrolled for a study program under the advice of the ISA Office.
- Assistance in completing the admission procedure at the university will be facilitated by ISA Office.
- First and foremost, the university will ensure and emphasize the opening of a bank account at a national bank within the campus. It is important to mention that payment from ICCR will be released only in the student's bank account. No cash transaction will be made.
- Foreign students will be facilitated to apply online for issuance of Residential Permit/Reporting at FRRO. In case of change of accommodation, change in residential address will be updated/informed to FRRO and ICCR.
- Upon completion of admission formalities, A joining report along with bifurcated fees structure of the entire course of each student will be issued by the concerned HoD and countersigned by the ISA. It will be uploaded by the students on their A2A Portal page with an intimation and copy of the joining report to ICCR Regional Office through eMail.
- Students will be advised to convey the copy of the Bank Passbook immediately to ICCR for the release of the scholarship.
- The ICCR will release the scholarship due only through PFMS.
- The ICCR will release tuition fees and compulsory fees of students. Refundable/ security fees/charges will be paid directly by the student.
- Hostel fees will be paid by students directly to the university.
- No dues of hostel fees should be completed by the student. The ICCR will not be liable to pay pending dues of students after the departure of students.



FACILITIES AND RESOURCES

Central Library

The Central library of CUTN has good collection of books, journals and e-resources catering to students, research scholars and faculty members. Presently, over 44,000 books, 589 CDs/DVDs and 200 printed journals are possessed by the library. It boasts access to more than 6000 online electronic journals through UGC-INFONET, e-ShodhSindhu, J-Gate, SCIFINDER to name a few. The IndiaStat.com database also has been subscribed towards the benefits of researchers and students for social science discipline. The library is completely automated having an online portal that can be easily accessed by the users. The library implemented KOHA - an open-source software package which is an integrated library management system that supports all housekeeping operations of the library. KOHA consists of modules on acquisition, cataloguing, circulation serials control and OPAC. Anyone can access these services within the campus. Recently the RFID technology is being used for security purposes. There is a separate digital library Centre having 30 computers running on high-speed internet. Overall, it offers seating capacity to over 100 users. The library is open from Monday to Friday (8 am - 12 am) and on Saturday (10 am - 6 pm). For the convenience of the users, the reprographic facility is also available inside the library. Other salient features include air conditioners, availability of portable water and property counter. Recently the MoU signed with INFLIBNET for Shodhganga project towards the sharing accessing of the Electronic Theses and Dissertations. Further, the Urkund & iThenticate Anti-Plagiarism Software access is enabled by the Central Library to check the theses and other publications for the benefits of students and faculty. The library system and staff are meticulously focused on providing a comfortable, user-friendly environment so as to enable learning and knowledge creation. Campus Wi-Fi Network: Campus Connect

Recently, the administration of the Central University of Tamil Nadu added a feather in its cap by the introduction of well-connected high-speed efficient internet facility. This can be accessed by all the students, research scholars and faculty members from any corner of the campus premises.

Health Care

The University Health Centre has both male and female doctors and nurses and other support staff. The health Centre is well-equipped with up to date stock of medicines and other facilities. The University administration is constantly updating medical technologies for comfort and convenience during emergency situations.



The Health Centre is open 24 x 7 throughout the year with efficient ambulance service. It has Tie up with the Medical College of Thiruvavur for referral and address emergencies.

Sports Facilities

Apart from education and research, the University also aims to promote a healthy culture of sports and fitness. Sports Office organizes a three-day sports meet annually in the university. Students engage themselves in a variety of sports activities that include basketball, badminton, football, cricket and volleyball. Indoor sports facilities include with respect to table tennis, carom, chess and yoga. There are separate indoor gyms in both girls and boys hostels.

Gastronomy

Fresh and healthy food and snacks are available at the coffee shop/cafeteria that is accompanied by a juice corner, sweet center and a bakery. North Indian, South Indian and Chinese dishes/cuisines/snacks are served at the cafeteria.



FACILITIES AND RESOURCES

Transport

Three buses are provided by the University that runs within the campus and to Kangalancherry, the nearest market place. These buses run in the morning, during lunchtime and in the evening to facilitate easy and comfortable movement.

Bank, ATM and Post Office

The University has a branch of State Bank of India open from 10 AM to 4 PM on all the working days. There are two ATMs, one in the main campus and another outside the residential campus. There is a post office on the main campus having all the basic facilities.

Hostels

Since the students of CUTN are from across the country, hostel facilities are of critical importance. The hostel is the second home for all students and scholars. Homely environment and safety are encouraged in the hostels. There are six hostels, of which, four are for students and two for research scholars. There are two boys hostels, two girls hostels which can house 500 students each. The rooms are allotted on a sharing basis.

The duly filled application form together with relevant documents must reach at university not later than 30th July 2024. The scanned application form must be sent via eMail along with the scanned e-Copies of relevant documents to international@cutn.ac.in not later than 30th July 2024.
2. The International Students Admission (ISA) Committee duly constituted by the university will meet to finalize the admissions, and successful candidates will be intimated via eMail. On receipt of the offer, the candidate(s) will have to accept the admission by paying the fee and submit the original documents to the ISA promptly.
3. Application Form should be filled legibly in English by the candidate in his/her own handwriting.
4. The applicant should write his/her name, father's name, mother's name as given in the school certificate of Board/University.
5. No column should be left blank in the application form. Incomplete application forms will be summarily rejected.
