Her Excellency, The President of India and The Visitor of Central University of Tamil Nadu, Smt. Droupadi Murmu to Grace Central University of Tamil Nadu's 10th Convocation

“The Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN) is set to host its 10th convocation on 03 September 2025, with a momentous presence of Her Excellency, The President of India, The Visitor of Central University of Tamil Nadu, Smt. Droupadi Murmu as the chief guest. The ceremony, scheduled from 02:30 PM to 03:20 PM at the CUTN's Multipurpose Hall in Neelakudi, Thiruvarur. The 10th convocation promises to be a landmark event for CUTN community.

The 10th Convocation at CUTN will feature a convocation address by Her Excellency, The President of India and The Visitor of Central University of Tamil Nadu, providing invaluable inspiration and encouragement to the graduands. During the event, Her Excellency The President of India, will personally confer Gold Medals upon top-ranking students.

This year, Gold Medals will be conferred upon 45 top-ranking graduands ((34 female and 11 male), and 44 doctoral graduands (27 female and 17 male) will receive their degrees, each of whom has made significant contributions to their respective fields of research. Of the 1,010 students graduating this year, 568 are female and 442 are male. A total of 771 graduands (454 female and 317 male) have opted to receive their degrees in person, representing a diverse mix of diploma, undergraduate, postgraduate and doctoral programmes.”

Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN) was established in 2009 by an Act of Parliament in the Thiruvarur district. Central University of Tamil Nadu has emerged as a vibrant centre of higher learning with 28 departments under 13 schools. The University is accredited with an A+ grade by NAAC and consistently ranked among the Top 100 institutions in India under NIRF ranking. Central University of Tamil Nadu has secured prestigious research grants, including FIST, PURSE, and PAIR, from agencies such as the DBT, DST, ANRF, ICSSR, and ICMR. As of August 2025, its scholarly impact is reflected in an *h*-index of 84.
