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## Tenth Convocation -2025



The Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN) held its 10th convocation on September 3, 2025, with Her Excellency, Smt. Droupadi Murmu, the President of India and Visitor of CUTN, is serving as the chief guest. She conferred degrees and delivered a keynote address, inspiring the 1,010 graduates present, comprising 568 female and 442 male students. A total of 45 Gold Medals were awarded to the top-ranking students, including 34 females and 11 males, alongside 44 doctoral degrees conferred to 27 female and 17 male scholars for their contributions to research. Of the graduating class, 771 students attended the ceremony, representing various diplomas, undergraduate, postgraduate, and doctoral programs. Founded in 2009, CUTN has developed into a prestigious institution with 28 departments across 13 schools, achieving A+ accreditation from NAAC and consistently ranking among the top 100 institutions in India in NIRF rankings. The university has also secured significant research funding from agencies such as DBT, DST, ANR, ICSIR, and ICMR, attesting to its strong academic performance, reflected in an h-index of 84 as of August 2025. CUTN remains committed to excellence in teaching, research, and innovation, striving to cultivate responsible citizens who will extend educational benefits throughout Bharat.


The Department of Geography has organized a special Lecture Series for the AY 202526, two invited lectures on the following topics.

## PSYFINITY 2025 – MENTAL HEALTH AWARENESS PROGRAMME



## Training programme

The Department of Geography has organized a five-day training programme on "Modern Land Surveying Techniques" from 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> October 2025. The programme covers technical sessions and practical demonstrations focusing on hands-on exposure to GNSS, Differential GNSS, Total Station, and Drone Mapping techniques, along with demonstrations on post-processing of survey data using Trimble Business Center software and Terrestrial LiDAR scanner. A total of 42 participants registered, out of which 20 participants were selected from various parts of India — including Delhi, Haryana, Punjab, Maharashtra, Kerala, Tamil Nadu, and an international participant from the United Kingdom. The sessions were conducted by experts from the Government Survey Training Institute, Orathanadu, independent survey and geospatial professionals, and Trimble representatives — they were supported by faculty members of the Department and school. The participants are trained on handling diverse modern survey instruments such as drone survey, static and real-time kinematic GNSS operations, and field spectroscopy, and also on data integration workflows with a complete field-to-lab learning experience. The programme concluded on 10th October 2025 with a valedictory session graced by Prof. M. Krishnan, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, Prof. R. Thirumurugan, Registrar, and Prof. Sulochana Shekhar, Controller of Examinations, CUTN.
