The candidates should have studied Tamil as one of the languages at Higher Secondary level. The candidates should not have completed 20 years of age as on 01.07.2026. Candidates who are appearing in March 2026 qualifying examination are also eligible to apply.

(Four Years)	Hindi		A Pass in the Plus two examination or equivalent of any recognized board in India with 60% marks for General Category, 55% marks for OBC (NCL)/EWS and 50% marks for SC/ST/PWD candidates. The candidates should have studied Hindi as one of the languages at Higher Secondary level. The candidates should not have completed 20 years of age as on 01.07.2026. Candidates who are appearing in March 2026 qualifying examination are also eligible to apply.

(Four Years)	English		A Pass in the Plus two examination or equivalent of any recognized board in India with 60% marks for General Category, 55% marks for OBC (NCL)/EWS and 50% marks for SC/ST/PWD candidates. The candidates should have studied English as one of the languages at Higher Secondary level. The candidates should not have completed 20 years of age as on 01.07.2026. Candidates who are appearing in March 2026 qualifying examination are also eligible to apply.
