

## **Facilities**

The Central University of Tamil Nadu (CUTN) was established by an Act of the Parliament (No. 25 of 2009) at Thiruvavur, Tamil Nadu. It is one of the twelve newly established Central Universities by the Government of India during the UGC XI Plan Period. About 520 acres of land spread across two revenue villages Neelakudi and Nagakudi has been generously provided by the State Government. The University is functioning in its own campus and it has progressively developed necessary infrastructure and facilities for its academic programmes. Besides academic facilities the university has an excellent residential campus. A green and carbon free campus is developed. We have also registered for a green rating and it may be noted that all the buildings are meeting GRIHA norms.

The Central University of Tamil Nadu has taken due care in providing necessary infrastructure to the students for a better learning. IT infrastructure is supported by National Knowledge Network (NKN) and National Mission for Education–Information and Communication Technology (NME-ICT) facilities and e-learning resources. Initiatives are taken for establishing smart classroom facilities for the students. The campus LAN and WIFI provisions are being taken up by the ERNET India. Optical Fibre Cable (OFC) connectivity has been established in the academic and administrative buildings. UGC Computer Center is also available for the access of the students. The hostels and the library are provided with sufficient WIFI facility. The science departments have their own research laboratories with high-end equipment. Research in CUTN is given prominence by equipping with state-of-art research facilities and providing conducive environment for the research scholars.

The university library was established in the year 2009 and it serves mainly the students, faculty members and non-teaching staff of the university. The library has a collection of about 19,000 books. Of these, more than 2000 books are catalogued as reference books (Handbooks, Dictionaries, Encyclopaedias, etc.,) and the rest are Text books and general books. Besides the printed books, the library also has 104 CDs/DVDs and subscribes to 20 print journals. In addition to these, the library has access to the UGC-INFONET Consortium for e-Resources, an online journal consortium funded by the UGC. The library is in constant touch with consortium agencies like UGC-INFONET for inclusion and addition of new journals and databases to support the new academic programmes. The library is also connected to the online resources such as UGC-

INFLIBNET and SCIFINDER. The library is automated with KOHA software, which is operational since 2013.

Amenities of students are progressively improved; for example, campuses photocopying centre, campus stationery shop, canteen, indoor stadium are a few to mention. The students' participation in cultural events both within the university and outside the university is laudable and memorable.

## Health Care Centre and own Ambulance facilities

- The university has a full-fledged health centre with full time Doctor and Health Assistants. Vehicle is deployed for 24x7 in Hostels / Residential Campus for emergency medical care. University is having its own ambulance.

- At present, the university hosts a branch of State Bank of India with ATM outlet at the Administration Block.

- Uninterrupted power supply.
- The university has entered into an MoU with Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Limited (TANGEDCO) for the installation of 110/33/11 KV substation for three-phase uninterrupted power supply. The substation work is in progress.

### **Transport facilities to cater to the needs of the students and staff**

The university is connected by public transport facilities. Apart from the government transport, three buses of the university have been provided for commutation for the students and staff within the campus and up to Kangalancherry and Vadakandam (3.5 km each from the university) for day scholars and staff members.

### **Facilities for persons with disabilities**

All the buildings have been provided with facility of ramp and lift.

### **Waste management facility**

**Sewage Water Management:** All the rain water from the terraces is being collected in sumps and used for construction purposes. Similarly, sewage treatment plants at Nagakudi and Neelakudi Campuses have been commissioned for treating the sewage water that is to be reused for gardening/horticulture purposes.

**Household Wastes/Garbage Management:** The household wastes and garbage is being collected in chambers and shifted by a local garbage collector to a designated places of Municipal Corporation i.e. Neivilakkuthoppu.

### Physical Facilities

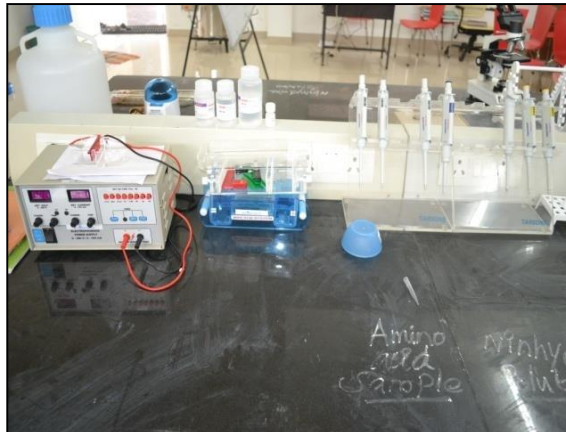

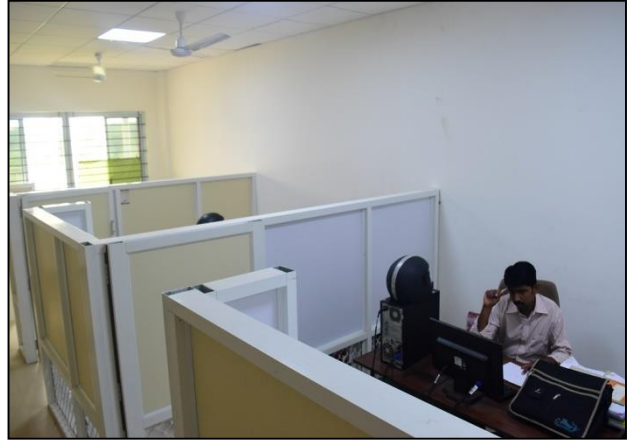
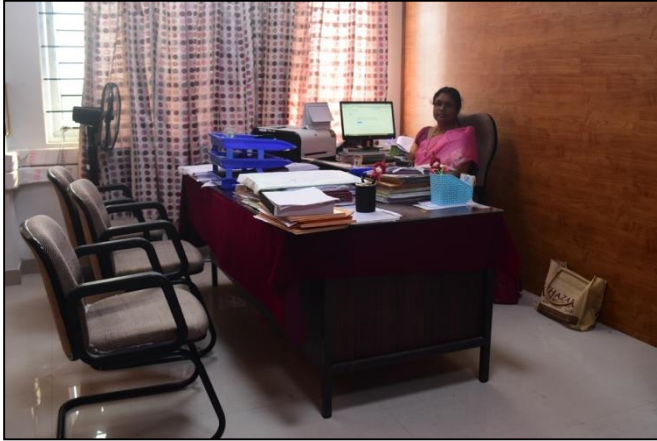
